It is the presence of Christ that calms the rough waters.

- I think of all of our schoolchildren who benefit from the coordination of activities through our Office of Catholic Education like the Catechism Bee, support and assistance for our principals; accompanying our schools through the accreditation process to achieve excellence in our schools:
- I think of our Faith Formation Office that spends time to prepare our students for the reception of the sacraments as well as to accompany young Christians searching for meaning and hope today;

- and the enthusiasm generated and hope given, resulting from the implementation of *V Encuentro* for engaging Hispanic families in the life of the Church:
- ■I think of our Native American Ministry that provides ongoing faith formation and sacramental services to our Native American community, highlighting cultural bonds and hope with the wider diocesan faith community;
- Permanent Deacon Formation programs that prepare new dedicated servants to become agents of hope in parish communities. Whether they will serve as new priests or serve as permanent deacons, they are dedicated to a ministry of service to the hospital, prison, food banks or other parish social ministries. Thus, hope is offered through the corporal and spiritual works of mercy;

I think of our National Collections, which are rolled into the CSA Appeal, like the Home Missions and the Black and Indian Mission Appeal, which offer hope for many others throughout our country to know and love Christ.

There are, of course, many more services that form an extraordinary mosaic of ministries throughout the Diocese of Gaylord. Our CSA campaign is a hopeful resource to keep Christ's redeeming message alive throughout the entire Diocese of Gaylord. As we join together on our common mission, we are **ANCHORED IN HOPE** and anchored in Christ.
