To bring your children to Mass on Sundays.

To bring your children to Mass on Holy Days of Obligation.

To bring your children to OCIA or Sacramental Prep gatherings faithfully.

To attend OCIA or Sacramental Prep parent meetings.

To attend OCIA liturgical rites.

To attend OCIA or Sacrament rehearsals for rites (when and if needed).
