On Wednesday, August 28, at his general audience, he once again appealed for the release of all hostages, a permanent ceasefire, and "the safe entry of humanitarian aid to be facilitated."

CNEWA & Pontifical Mission, with its office in Jerusalem, and in collaboration with well-established partnerships will continue to work to bring humanitarian and psychosocial assistance to the suffering people. We join with all our partners in the hope that soon safe corridors of passage will enable the needed amounts of such assistance to reach all who are suffering, in search of clean water, starving, in need of medical assistance, displaced, without hope.

Your Excellency, CNEWA thanks you and your most generous people for their sacrifice and solidarity with the people of Gaza at this hour.
